



# How much space do we need?

### Premises

3.57. The premises and equipment must be organised in a way that meets the needs of children. Providers must meet the following indoor space requirements<sup>51</sup>.

- Children under two years:  $3.5 \text{ m}^2$  per child
- Two year olds:  $2.5 \text{ m}^2$  per child
- Children aged three to five years:  $2.3 \text{ m}^2$  per child

Number of under 2's

$$= \boxed{\quad} \times 3.5 = \boxed{\quad}$$

Total square metres =

Number of 2 year olds

$$= \boxed{\quad} \times 2.5 = \boxed{\quad}$$

Number of 3-5 year olds =

$$\boxed{\quad} \times 2.3 = \boxed{\quad}$$

Now add these three numbers together




This number will be different when you have different numbers of children and different ages in the rooms and the building.

The green number MUST be smaller than the Pink number!

What is your usable space in your nursery building?

(Do not include kitchens, offices, staff areas and bathrooms)
